

RESPONSIBLE CONDUCT IN RESEARCH TRAINING PLAN

The Cary Institute of Ecosystem Studies recognizes the importance of educating the future scientists that are trained and mentored at our research facilities in the Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) and fostering an environment that promotes the responsible conduct in research.

Our training will consist of a series of online training modules on the various responsible conduct topics. In addition, a binder with up-to-date reference material on these topics will be made available in the library. Reference books and material covering responsible conduct and research will be available in the Grants and Compliance Office. The online training will be supplemented with a biannual seminar and in lab training.

Our Research Experience for Undergraduate (REU) students will receive training in responsible conduct in research by a member of the senior scientific staff at the beginning of their summer research program. They will also have access to the online training modules, the in-house reference material and the seminars.
